Introduction

Today we are going to dive into Gideon's next steps, as he was Called by God to lead his people and look at Next Steps for us. Do you know what I love about the OT? The stories, and I know some of them might be bizarre, weird and hard to understand, but these stories are full of real lives, though in different times, just like us...similar struggles, behaviors and pitfalls. Things we can relate to, things we can learn from. So as we go through this next chapter, we'll unpack what is going on then and see how it applies to us now.

Big Idea: God's isn't looking at what you have, He's looking at what you'll do

Three main points to remember when look at this passage.

1. When you trust God numbers don't matter
2. God encourages in the midst of fear (not the absent of fear)
3. Trust God when the odds are against you

(Questions to get everyone to participate)

1. What is your greatest fear (flying, heights, spiders, etc...)?
2. What is the craziest thing you've done (of for God)?

(Questions based on the primary text)

Read Judges 7:1-22

3. When did defeat look evitable in your life? How did you respond?
4. We see God benching some of Gideon's team, when have you been benched or didn't make the cut?
5. How does fear play a role in trusting God in your life?
6. What are we supposed to do with our fears in trusting God?
7. Describe a time when God encouraged you when you were afraid.
8. What does it mean to trust God?
